- 1. Establishing a governance structure that ensures compliance with our climate strategy.
- 2. Aligning the new business portfolio with the expectations presented by a transition to a low-carbon economy.
- 3. Identifying, assessing, and managing risks and opportunities related to climate change, throughout the life cycle of projects and integrating them into operational and business planning.
- 4. Gradually achieving carbon neutrality and promoting it within the company and throughout the value chain.
- 5. Establishing short, medium, and long-term mitigation and adaptation goals and the corresponding plan to achieve them and ensure their compliance.
- 6. Continuously improving our climate performance and reporting it annually following internationally accepted frameworks.
- 7. Increasing the resilience of our operations and surrounding communities with a risk management and prevention approach.
- 8. Working with other stakeholders to promote solutions that address climate change and its effects.
